Please use this reference manual in conjunction with the wireframes document ("Image-Textflow e-Reader Project Document") previously delivered.

This specs document will focus on design layout, typography and color. Additionally, there are some slight UI updates that have been covered for business reasons that are not reflected in the wireframes document.

The layout of the mobile reader has been designed with handheld devices in mind; specifically, the iPhone IOS.

Max widths of each design comp has been formatted in a 320 pixel-wide format.

Additionally, all fonts take advantage of the Open Sans typeface, readily available for cross-device users on the Internet.

Max widths of each design comp has been formatted in a 320 pixel-wide format.






### **Height specifications**

The default header (shown above) features the blue background main navigation, followed by a 3-pixel level drop shadow (evolving from #CCC to #FFF).

### **Header Permutations**

Please note that the comprehensive height to headers may differ according to client.


If the customized color rules are employed (2 stacked 2-pixel high rules), the format of the header will be slightly adjusted.

Additionally, the placement of the drop shadow will be moved to properly accommodate the elements.




The default header above with the included drop-down menu activated. Please note how the presence of the menu pushes the drop shadow (mentioned above) down.





The customized header (shown above) features the blue background main navigation, followed by (2) 2-pixel high rules, footed by the 3-pixel level drop shadow.



Lastly, above is the customized header, followed by the dropdown menu and completed by the drop shadow.


### **Header Permutations (cont'd)**

There are also customers who may personalize their user experience by inclusion of school colors designated in their account preferences.

These color choices include 2 separate 2-pixel high rules that appear immediately below the blue navigation area.

See the two examples and how these color rules interact with the top navigation design.






### **Navigation Behaviors**


### **Slider Control Behaviors**








Fig. 7: WF-06-01-02 Text View N/A




Fig. 13: WF-07-01-02 Title has no Table of Contents Available






